

AUSTSWIM as an RTO providing swim teacher courses, is the only provider to cover the important skill of how to teach safer diving in its Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety course. As part of our stringent licensing process, we not only cover the content as part of our course workshops but additionally in our licensing requirements.

We aim to ensure that learners are fully aware of the correct and appropriate depths for teaching diving as well as the progressive teaching practices and teaching points needed to learn this essential skill. A dive entry can be used for recreational purposes for competitions (diving from the side of the pool, not the blocks) as well as to make a quick entry in an emergency situation.

The Guidelines for Safe Pool Operations (GSPO), have recently updated the content on all forms of diving and the new guidelines come into effect from July 2026. You can find relevant information on the correct and approved depths for teaching diving here:

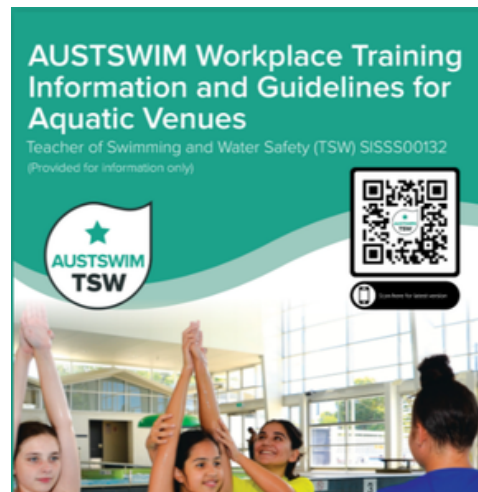

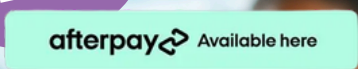
