


AUSTSWIM Teacher of Adults (AD)

Prerequisites

Any teacher who holds a Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety licence or accreditation (Statement of Attainment is accepted) from AUSTSWIM or another provider, can enrol in AUSTSWIM extension courses.

- Drinks and snacks as required
- T shirt/rash vest to wear over bathers
